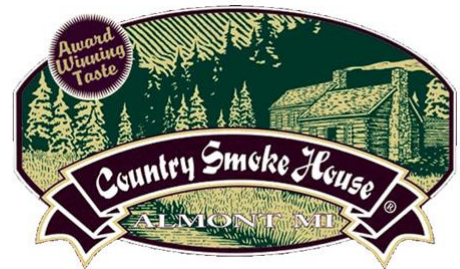

BENEFITING CHARITIES:

- **Abigayle Ministries** - located at 12313 Nineteen Mile Road, Sterling Heights, MI. Founded in 1997, Abigayle's place is a home where shelter is provided for pregnant women, nurturing and educating them with basic life skills, Bible Study and a wide variety of educational courses. Abigayle also reaches out to mothers and their children in the surrounding community through Abby's Resource Center to help them meet their material needs with diapers, formula and clothing.
- **Convoy of Hope** — faith-based, nonprofit organization with a driving passion to feed the world through children's feeding initiatives, community outreaches and disaster response. www.convoyofhope.org
- **Crossroads Pregnancy Center** - located at 3205 E. South Boulevard, Auburn Hills, MI. CPC is dedicated to helping abortion-vulnerable women and men who are involved in a crisis pregnancy situation, to choose life for their unborn children. Towards the same end, CPC is committed to encouraging godly sexual attitudes and practices in their community.
- **Gateway to Glory Ministries, Inc.** - located in Sterling Heights, MI, Gateway To Glory is dedicated to helping the less fortunate and often forgotten members of society: ex-offenders, men in recovery and those who need a new start. The mission is to change the lives of men and through them, the lives of their families by creating an environment offering education, inspiration, encouragement, vocational training and mentoring. Through this ministry men will learn the tools needed to become responsible, productive members of society, heads of households and caring role models for their children.
- **Interfaith Volunteer Caregivers** - a non-profit 501 (c)(3) organization that provides assistance to older and disabled adults who need help to remain safe and independent in their own homes. Our program pairs volunteers of all ages with persons in need to provide services including: transportation, errands, minor home repairs, light housekeeping, supportive visits and calls, respite breaks for full-time family caregivers, and other assistance that can help someone to remain at home for as long as possible. Because more than half of those we serve live at or below the poverty level, we do not charge for our services. Instead, we must rely on the generosity of the local community to carry out our mission. Since our inception 23 years ago, we have been able to serve over 3,000 people in need through our committed corps of over 4,000 volunteers! Our program also provides meaningful volunteer opportunities for those seeking to enrich their lives and live out their faith by helping others. - **Macomb County Rotating Emergency Shelter Team (MCREST)** - located at 20415 Erin, Roseville, MI, MCREST has been serving the homeless since 1988. Their Mission Statement is to provide homeless and displaced individuals the opportunity for a successful transition to independence.
- **Power Company Kids Club (PCKC)** - located at 530 East Pike, Pontiac, MI. Their Mission Statement: The Power Company Kids Club is dedicated to promoting the emotional, physical, spiritual, and social wellbeing of the at-risk children and teens of our inner cities through weekly Bible teaching, mentoring and cooperation with parents, churches, community organizations, schools and civic leaders in the area.
